

Frontloading

Cognitive- 1: of, relating to, being, or involving conscious intellectual activity (as thinking, reasoning, or remembering) <*cognitive* impairment. 2: based on or capable of being reduced to **empirical** factual knowledge

Psychomotor- of or relating to motor action directly proceeding from mental activity

Affective- relating to, arising from, or influencing feelings or emotions : **EMOTIONAL**
<cognitive and *affective* symptoms>

2: expressing emotion <*affective* language>

— **af·fec·tive·ly** *adverb*

— **af·fec·tiv·i·ty** \,a-,fek-'ti-və-tē\ *noun*

Automatism

a : the quality or state of being **automatic**

b : an automatic action

suspension of the conscious mind to release subconscious images <*automatism* —the surrealist trend toward spontaneity and intuition — *Elle*>

Internalization- to give a subjective character to; *specifically* : to incorporate (as values or patterns of culture) within the self as conscious or subconscious guiding principles through learning or socialization

— **in·ter·nal·i·za·tion** \-,tər-nə-lə-'zā-shən\ *noun*

Assimilation- the process of receiving new facts or of responding to new situations in conformity with what is already available to consciousness

Accommodation- the state of being

Profess- to practice or claim to be versed in (a calling or **profession**)
